


Over 12,000 people fed through Dover Foodbank

In 2016 we reported that we had been privileged to support a total of over 5,000 people since opening in 2013 by providing them with 3 days' worth of food and other essentials.



In March of 2019, this exceeded 12,000, with numbers increasing each month. In any 6-month period the Foodbank typically supports over 400 different households at least once. This is a huge increase compared with 2017, when this figure was just over 250. The food supplied by our generous donors helps both children and adults as the data in this chart shows.
